



Our commitment to doubling the number of patients served

CASA set an ambitious goal in 2022 to double the number of kids and family members we serve by 2025. Our reach dropped significantly during COVID from an estimated average of 4,000 each year to approximately 2,500. We made a commitment to return to our average and double it to 8,000 kids, youth AND family members - something we hadn't accurately captured before.

As of March 2024, we are proud to say we've reached 7,100 children, youth and family members across the province, through our many Edmonton-based programs and our CASA Classrooms now across several Alberta communities.
