Leading with Heart: New Director to Help Expand Day Programs and CASA House

More facilities, more capacity, more service for Alberta families. CASA Mental Health is expanding its CASA House, Adolescent Day Program and **CASA Classrooms** across Alberta. Recently, we welcomed two new directors to our Senior Leadership Team who will lead the expansion of these programs and help us achieve the goals in our five-year strategic roadmap. These directors will champion CASA's vision for a community where all children, youth and their families are provided with timely mental health care and are empowered to thrive.

Tanya Kendall, Director, Clinical (Day Programs and CASA House) is a heartfirst, action-oriented person. As a leader and one of CASA's newest directors, she's also committed to building a mental health system that wraps around kids and families, to provide more timely mental health care closer to the communities where kids live and learn.

Quadrupling Mental Health Beds for Alberta Youth

CASA Mental Health is excited to partner with the Government of Alberta and Clark Builders to build livein and day program CASA House facilities in three new locations: Medicine Hat, Fort McMurray and Calgary.

This is part of a \$75 million capital commitment from the Government of Alberta, which will also support a new CASA House in the Edmonton region to replace the existing Sherwood Park facility. Once operational, the number of CASA House beds will quadruple to about 80 across the province and will treat more than 300 Alberta youth every year.



CASA House, located in Sherwood Park, is a live-in program for teens who need support with significant mental health and/or addiction challenges.

The four facilities — each over 30,000 square feet — will include trauma-informed design shaped by input from patients, families and mental health experts. The Fort McMurray and Calgary locations are anticipated to open their doors in the fall of 2027, with Medicine Hat and Edmonton following in 2029.
